



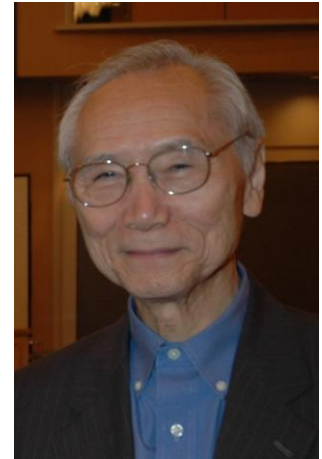

1988 Professor of Princeton University

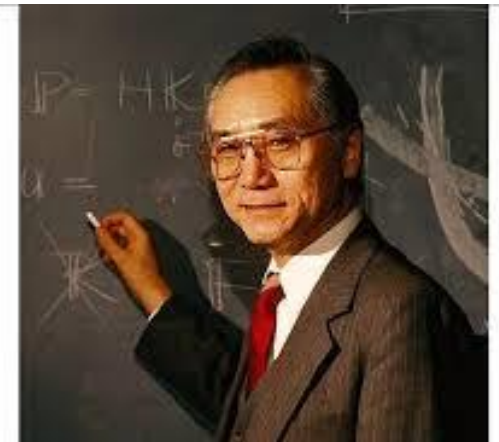
1995 Professor of University of Southern California

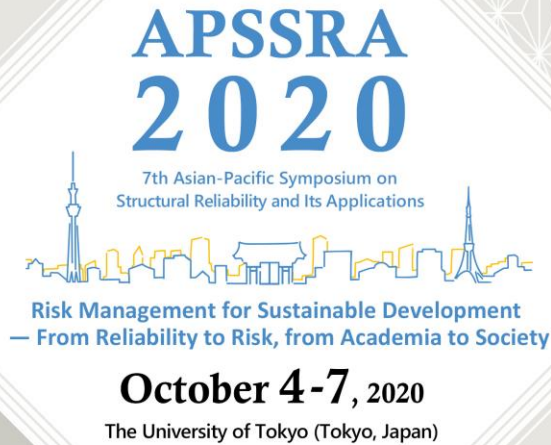
